

REGISTRATION

For current families, in order to hold your spot at MHA, registration fee must be paid by **Jan. 31st to FACTS**.

For new families, you will have one week from the date on the acceptance email to pay the registration fee, to hold your child's position in the class.

REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee covers student accident insurance, technology (1:1 program), Suzuki Program, FACTS, yearbook, PTA dues, school supplies (PS- 5), lower school field trips and class parties, middle school textbooks, class dues and electives (6-12), PSAT test (10-11), one ACT or SAT test, student association dues, two banquets, Real World Learning, school wide MHA apparel item and music dues. **The registration fee is nonrefundable.** * For students registering for January 2019 or later, the fee will be pro-rated at 75%.

** No refunds of the registration payment will be given except for:*

- Moving/Relocation 50+ miles away from MHA
- The family has a completed and verified application for tuition assistance on file by the deadline, and has determined that the amount is not sufficient
- Educational needs for the student that can no longer be met at MHA as determined by Administration
- Withdrawal at the request of MHA
- Family status changes supported by court documents
- Military service orders supported by documentation

For those reasons only, the registration payment will be refunded prior to starting classes, minus a \$50 administrative fee, once the family has emailed the business department.

STUDENT LABOR

Student earnings from campus jobs can help offset tuition and other fees at MHA. Please see office if interested.

PARENT COMMITMENT

All MHA families are required to commit to 20 volunteer hours (or a \$200 donation), per year.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Limited financial assistance is available each year based on established need. An outside tuition management company, FACTS, reviews each application to determine eligibility. Both a completed financial aid application form and a copy of the previous year's federal tax return (1040) must be submitted before any consideration will be given for financial aid. This application is available on our website or at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/45VMG>. Tuition assistance may be available to qualifying students via the additional following sources:

ACE Scholarship: Families must qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program to qualify for this scholarship. Applications may be picked up in the office.

Church Tuition Assistance: Some churches provide tuition assistance to eligible members. Please contact your church pastor for further information.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

Parents who enroll students in MHA have entered into a contractual agreement with the school and are expected to live up to these commitments. Monthly balances or approved financial agreements must be kept current.

If the family's account is not current, the student will be allowed to take final exams, but will not have access to report cards on RenWeb until their account is current with the financial agreement.

It is not the intent of the Administration to exclude children from school, but to emphasize to parents the need for them to contact the school office to make other arrangements when they cannot make their tuition payments on time. In addition, it is Mile High Academy's Policy that no student shall receive a diploma/transcript/report card, if any financial obligations are outstanding. TUITION

Tuition does not cover the full cost of operating MHA. Members of the SDA Church support Adventist education with substantial church and conference subsidies. MHA is supported by four constituent churches: Denver South, Denver West, LifeSource, and Littleton. Students who are members of one of these churches will receive a percentage off the listed tuition rate. Please contact the office for rates.

TUITION PRE-PAYMENT DISCOUNT

A 5% discount is given on tuition if paid for the entire school year. **Payment(s) must be received no later than June 1st through FACTS.**

TUITION BILLING PROCEDURES

Tuition is divided into ten (10) installments and billed July through May, leaving January a free tuition month to pay registration fees for the following year. A monthly statement will be emailed/mailed to the responsible party from FACTS. Parents may access their tuition and fees account through FACTS at any time and set up auto pay. Tuition is due the 5th or 20th of the month depending on the date selected with FACTS. A late fee of \$25 per month per family will be charged if payment is not received by the due date.

INTERNATIONAL TUITION

International students will be charged 125% of the tuition rate. This does not include residential fees, registration fees, transportation, and other miscellaneous fees.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Tuition discounts are given to families with more than one child in attendance at Mile High Academy. The discount is applied to the tuition of the younger child(ren).

- 1st Student – Full Tuition
- 2nd Student – 5% discount
- 3rd Student – 10% discount
- 4th Student – 20% discount
- 5th Student – 25% discount

GRADUATION COSTS

MHA will provide diplomas, honor pins, and recognition cords for graduating seniors. All other expenses will be deducted from the trust funds or are the students' responsibilities. Transcripts or diplomas will be issued only when the student's account is clear.

EARLY WITHDRAWAL

Students who withdraw during the school year must pay all of his/her outstanding accounts including full tuition for the quarter/trimester they are in attendance, and receive financial clearance from the finance office on the withdrawal forms.

ACT, SAT, AP TEST: The cost of either one ACT or one SAT is included in the registration fee charged to juniors & seniors. PSAT test is included in registration fee for sophomores and juniors. Students are responsible to pay for any additional ACT, SAT, PSAT or AP tests.

TEXTBOOKS: All upper school students and middle school students taking upper school classes are required to purchase and supply their own textbooks. MHA will provide a list of books and ISBN numbers so that a student may purchase new or used books online.

SPORTS: Sport fees are collected by the Athletic Department at the beginning of each season and are non-refundable after the first week.
