REGISTRATION INFORMATION

To secure your spot for the upcoming school year, registration fees are collected via FACTS by January 31 or within 10 days of enrollment.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Registration covers essential school resources, including technology, insurance, Lower School supplies and field trips, yearbook, and student dues.

REFUND POLICY

Registration fees are fully refundable until May 31. After that, refunds will only be provided under specific circumstances.

TUITION OVERVIEW

MHA tuition is subsidized by the Rocky Mountain Conference and local Adventist churches, which allows us to offer a reduced rate for Adventist members. Tuition is billed over 10 months, from July through May, with no tuition due in January. January is reserved for collecting registration fees for the upcoming school year. Families receive monthly statements via FACTS and are required to set up auto-pay for tuition and incidental charges.

STUDENT FINANCIAL AID

Need-based financial aid is available through FACTS, which requires an application and a copy of your most recent tax return.

Additional financial assistance options include ACE Scholarships for families who qualify and tuition assistance provided by your local church.
